**ALL VOTERS:** Justice of the Supreme Court Primary - Vote for ONE  
*The two with the most votes will appear on the April 3 ballot.*

#### IMPORTANT DATES

**Wed, Jan 31** - Last day to register to vote online at [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov) or by mail.

**Mon Feb 5 - Fri, Feb 16** - In-Person Absentee (Early Voting) dates and hours vary.

Contact your **Municipal Clerk**. Visit [myvote.wi.gov/en-us/MyMunicipalClerk](http://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/MyMunicipalClerk) to get contact information for your clerk.

**Thurs., Feb. 15** - Last day to request Absentee Ballot by mail. **NOTE:** Ballot **WILL NOT** be counted if received after February 20 at 8 p.m. Ballots may be returned to your polling place on Election Day.

**Sat-Mon, Feb.17-19** - **NO** in-person absentee voting or registration.

**Tues. Feb. 20** - You may register to vote at your polling place on Election Day. Bring proof of residence to register and a photo ID to vote.

★ **NEED A PHOTO ID?**

★ **Get one trip service at the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).** Photo IDs are FREE for voting purposes, if you never had one.

★ **NO BIRTH CERTIFICATE? The DMV can assist you.**

★ **ABSENTEE VOTING (EARLY VOTING)**

★ **BY MAIL** - ANYONE can request to vote absentee by mail. Request an Absentee ballot by February 15 at [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov) or by asking your clerk. "Indefinitely confined" absentee voters **DO NOT** need a photo ID.



★ **IN-PERSON**

- **City of Milwaukee** - Mon. Feb 5 - Fri Feb 16 from 8:30 - 4:30 in City Hall, Room 501
- **Other Milwaukee County Municipalities** - For early voting hours and locations, contact your clerk's office - Find your municipal clerk at [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov)

★ **ON ELECTION DAY**, you can still register AND vote at the polls.

○ **To REGISTER, you must provide proof of where you live.** Proof documents list [HERE](#).

○ **To VOTE, you must have acceptable photo ID.** Picture guide [HERE](#).

○ **NO PHOTO ID?** Ask for a provisional ballot and return to your clerk with documentation by Friday after the Election.
